



EVA DEMYEN APPOINTED ACTING SUPERINTENDENT

The Board of Education is pleased to announce that on August 20, 2019, the Board appointed veteran administrator Eva Demyen to serve as Acting Superintendent for the 2019-2020 school year. Ms. Demyen is a highly respected school administrator who brings with her the experience and knowledge needed to successfully lead our District in the right direction.

Ms. Demyen retired from the Deer Park Union Free School District in June of 2019, where she served as the Superintendent of Schools for ten years. Prior to becoming Superintendent, Ms. Demyen served as Deputy Superintendent for three years and, prior to that, she served as the Director of Mathematics for Deer Park for three years. She also spent 13 years as the Director of Mathematics for the Valley Stream Central High School.

During her ten years as Superintendent for Deer Park, Ms. Demyen worked collaboratively with the Board of Education, administration and staff to improve instructional and evaluation processes and increase the District's standing academically and financially in the County. She helped foster the growth of Fine and Performing Arts initiatives by maintaining valuable programs for all students. She led the way for increased participation rates in advanced courses and additional AP course offerings for students. She also assisted with increasing extracurricular and after-school programs for students.

Before becoming an administrator, Ms. Demyen spent her first 15 years in education as a math teacher and a math substitute teacher. She is a past Chairman for the National Council of Teachers of Mathematics, a past President for the Nassau County Association of Mathematics Supervisors and a past Treasurer and Legislative Committee member for the Suffolk County School Superintendents Association. She has presented on leadership and math staff development for school districts and organizations across Long Island.

Ms. Demyen is excited to take on this new role at Roosevelt and is dedicated to achieving success for all of our students and staff.
