Academics-If you have concerns about issues such as: your child's academic performance/progress, questions about the curriculum or how it is being taught in class, please observe the following contact protocol:

1st contact - Teacher
 2nd contact - Guidance Counselor
 3rd contact - Asst. Principal
 4th contact - Principal

Behavior-If you have concerns about issues such as: possible bullying or harassment of your child at school, the way that your child's teacher relates to him/her; your child does not seem to be fitting in or has few or no friends; your child often appears to be depressed, unhappy or is very stressed, please observe the following contact protocol.:

1st contact - Teacher/Guidance Counselor
 2nd contact - School Psychologist/Social Worker
 3rd contact - Asst. Principal
 4th contact - Principal

Athletic & Extra-curricular Activities-If you would like to get your child involved in after school activities, have questions about an extra-curricular activity, want information regarding the "cut" policy, or would like to know why your child was "cut" from an athletic team; please observe the following contact protocol:

1st contact - Coach/Club Advisor
 2nd contact - Athletic Director/ Chairperson
 3rd contact - Asst. Principal
 4th contact – Principal
