Dear Parents/Guardians:

The Roosevelt Union Free School District believes that one of the most important ways in which to ensure that our children perform well in their classroom is to provide them with the nutrition necessary for the healthy growth of their minds and bodies. Therefore, we are excited to inform you that for the 2020/2021 school year, the District has been approved to participate in the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) program. Under this program, on a daily basis, the District is able to provide a healthy breakfast and lunch to all students at no cost to the parents/guardians.

All parents/guardians are strongly encouraged to complete and submit a Household Income Eligibility Form. This form is needed for two reasons: (1) it will determine if your middle/high school child(ren) qualifies for additional benefits (i.e., possible reduction in college application fees, PSAT/SAT/ACT fee waivers, etc.); and, (2) it helps the District to maintain accurate records of the meals provided to our students, ensuring that we receive the right State Aid that is due.

Enclosed, you will find a CEP Household Income Eligibility Form. Please read the instructions, complete the form and return it to your child's school as soon as possible.

Este formulario se necesita por dos razones: (1) determinará si su hijo en la escuela intermedia y secundaria califican para beneficios adicionales, es decir, una posible reducción de matrícula universitaria, exámenes de ingreso a la Universidad, extensiones de pago, etc...; y (2) ayuda al distrito a mantener datos de las comidas que se le han brindado, asegurando que recibamos la debida ayuda económica estatal.
